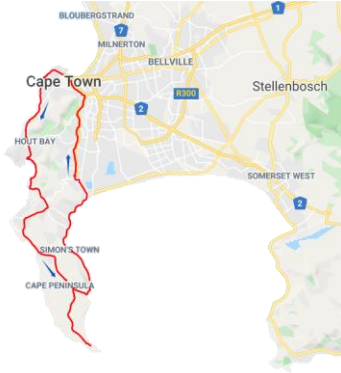

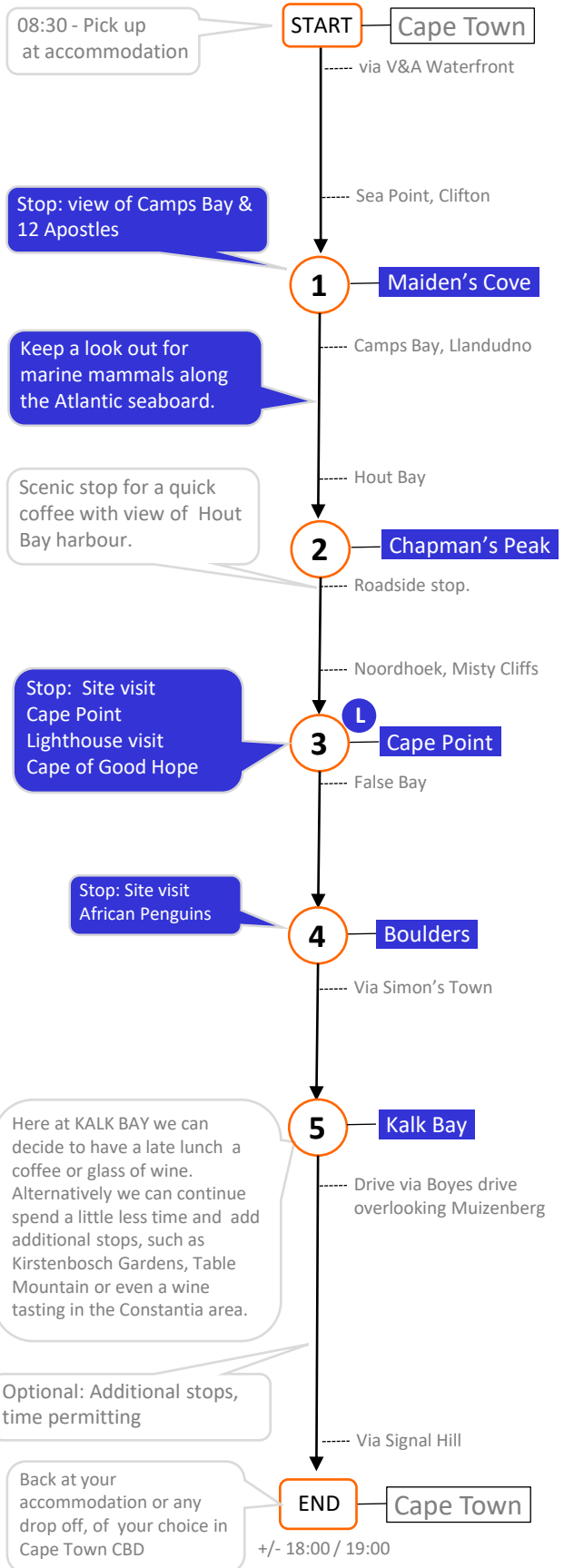

Day Trip



You will be collected from your accommodation at 08:30 in Cape Town CBD. Be sure to wear comfortable clothing and shoes, all sites along the coast could be windy & cold at times. Cape Town is known for its four seasons in one day.

Our journey starts with a drive through the V&A Waterfront. We then head along the coastal road passing Sea Point, Bantry Bay & Clifton. Our 1st stop is at Maiden's Cove with the fantastic Camps Bay beach in front of you and the 12 Apostles (Table Mountain) as a backdrop.

Keep your eyes peeled for any sighting of Dolphins or Whales. Making our way past Llandudno, we drop into Hout Bay. Ahead of us lies Chapman's Peak drive with magnificent views of Hout Bay harbour. Along this section we will stop at a viewpoint and enjoy a freshly brewed coffee or tea.

As we round Chapman's Peak, we steer past Noordhoek beach and onto Misty Cliffs, a peaceful little hang out with cottages on the waters' edge. Moving on to Cape Point which will be our first stop, where you are welcome to utilise the funicular or take a 15 min walk to the lighthouse for some incredible views of the Peninsula. It is also here that we will have lunch. We suggest a grab n go vs. being seated at the restaurant as that can take a very long time. Alternatives for lunch is available and we will discuss this here. Our next stop is Cape of Good Hope for that iconic photograph.

Heading out from Cape Point, False Bay opens up in front of us. As we approach Simon's Town, we visit a breeding colony of African Penguins that is endemic to the South African coastline. Following the boardwalks we will get up close and personal. Our next stop is Kalk Bay for a coffee, shopping or a glass of wine. At this point it will be your decision how long we will stay to enjoy the many little shops and restaurants this eclectic little seaside village has to offer. The alternative is to head on towards Kirstenbosch Botanical gardens or do a late afternoon Table Mountain visit or stop off at Signal Hill for a sunset drink.
